

SkillsUSA Georgia T-Shirt

Purpose:

To allow SkillsUSA Georgia members to develop an annual t-shirt that can be worn to local, regional, state, and national meetings that will identify members as representing SkillsUSA Georgia. The winning design will be chosen for its ability to catch the consumer's eye and depict SkillsUSA Georgia's pride. First, second, and third place will be awarded at the State Leadership and Skills conference. There will not be a regional or national contest in this event.

Eligibility:

The contest is open to active SkillsUSA Georgia members. There is not a limit to the number of entries from each school. Each contestant must be registered for the State Conference, and be present to take the SkillsUSA PDP test at the State Conference along with all the other contestants.

Deadline:

Contest entries must be turned in at the registration table at the State Conference.

Regulations:

1. The SkillsUSA logo **does not** have to be incorporated into the design. If the logo is used it may be either the SkillsUSA national logo, state logo or chapter logo. Proper guidelines for logo use can be found at: <http://skillsusa.org/about/logos2.shtml>
2. Please note that when using just the word SkillsUSA, it is considered one word and a space should not separate Skills and USA.
3. The contestant's name, school, and advisor should be placed on the back of the design.
4. The design must be submitted on an 8 ½ X 11" sheet of paper.

Evaluation:

The design will be judged on the following:

- Layout and Design: 0-25 points
- Creativity and Originality: 0-25 points
- Workmanship: 0-20 points
- Suitability: 0-20 points
- Overall Impression: 0-10 points
