

SkillsUSA GEORGIA POWERPOINT PRESENTATION

PURPOSE:

To prepare a PowerPoint Presentation that promotes SkillsUSA at the state and local level.

ELIGIBILITY:

Open to any active SkillsUSA member. Schools may enter more than one contestant. Contestants are eligible to enter other contests. (Example: A Graphic Communications students may enter the PowerPoint Presentation contest also).

SUBMISSION:

All entries must register for this state only contest. Contest entries must be submitted at the designated time and place during the State Conference. Contestants will take the PDP test and submit a resume.

AWARDS:

Gold, Silver and Bronze medals will be awarded for 1st, 2nd and 3rd place. The winner of this contest does not advance to the National SkillsUSA Competition.

SCOPE OF THE CONTEST:

The contestant will create a PowerPoint presentation that promotes SkillsUSA at the state and local level.

1. Using text, photographs, artwork, sound, video and animation, the PowerPoint presentation should include information that promotes the SkillsUSA Georgia State Association. The PowerPoint presentation must include the Champions At Work slogan and the SkillsUSA logo. Refer the national website (www.skillsusa.org) for guidelines on using the SkillsUSA logo.
2. The winning PowerPoint presentation will be posted on the state website for members to download and personalize for their local chapter.
3. During registration at the state conference, the contestant will submit a printed copy of their PowerPoint presentation with a CD containing the PowerPoint file.
4. The presentation should not contain more than 20 slides and should not take more than two minutes to play.

EVALUATION CRITERIA:

1. Layout and Appearance
2. Organization
3. Typography selection
4. Creativity
5. Flow of Presentation (Use of transitions, sound, and animation)
