

TACTICAL TEAM STATE ONLY COMPETITION

PURPOSE:

The purpose of this competition is to evaluate a team's ability to conduct a variety of maneuvers common to tactical scenarios.

CLOTHING REQUIREMENTS:

Industry appropriate shirt, pants and closed toe shoes (boots and tennis shoes preferred) are expected. Skirts and high-heeled shoes are not permitted.

ELIGIBILITY:

Open to a team of no more than four members who are active SkillsUSA members enrolled in a Public Safety & Government Pathway program. Team members must be from the same SkillsUSA chapter and not entered in any other SkillsUSA contest.

SUBMISSION:

Contestant will compete onsite at the SkillsUSA Georgia State Leadership and Skills Conference. Contestants should present their resumes at the time of the contest. Contestants will take the PDP

AWARDS:

Gold, Silver and Bronze medals will be awarded for 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place. The winner of this contest does not advance to the National SkillsUSA Leadership and Skills Conference.

EQUIPMENT AND MATERIALS:

Supplied by the technical committee: All necessary materials for the particular scenario in the given contest.

Supplied by the contestant: students will not be allowed to use equipment unless it is listed below. This competition is about skills and training not equipment. All needed equipment will be provided.

- a.) Small pocket notebook for field notes
- b.) Belt and training holster
- c.) Pens and pencils
- d.) Handcuffs
- e.) Handcuff cases
- f.) Flashlight

SCOPE OF THE CONTEST:

1. Contestants will demonstrate their ability to perform jobs or skills selected from the following list of competencies as determined by the SkillsUSA Championships technical committee.
 - a) Explain constitutional law, criminal law, laws of arrest, rules of evidence, & search and seizure.
 - b) Describe and demonstrate patrol procedures.
 - c) Demonstrate defensive techniques.
 - d) Use tactical movement and communication
 - e) Demonstrate proper felony handcuffing procedure
 - f) Discuss the legal aspects of firearms.
 - g) Demonstrate proper use of firearms and chemical agents.

- h) Demonstrate communication skills.
 - i) Demonstrate interpersonal skills.
 - j) Use crisis intervention techniques.
 - k) Apply basic elements of emergency response &/or first aid.
 - l) Demonstrate arrest procedures.
 - m) Conduct a search incident to arrest.
2. Contestants must work together as a team without assistance from instructors, other contestants, or observers.
 3. The contest will include an exam covering constitutional and criminal law.
