### **Can advisors and parents come to the competition?**

Due to the lack of space, **only contestants** will be allowed on premise on the day of competition. Lunch is provided for contestants.

### **What information do I need to provide to PIAG?**

### **Does my contestant need to submit a resume?**

Yes, a resume for your contestant should be emailed from the advisor to PIAG at [ian@piag.org](mailto:ian@piag.org). Contestants may bring their resume on the day of competition; however, they are usually nervous and often forget. Points will be deducted during their interview if a resume is not emailed by the advisor prior to the competition or brought with the contestant to Danger Press.

### **What areas of the Screen Print will be judged?**

Screen coating, screen exposure/washout, screen blockout, image registration, image printing, screen reclaiming, quality control, and oral assessment.
